





Summer Steelhead/Sea Run Cutthroat guided fishing trip for two fishermen for two consecutive days on the Cowlitz River of SW Washington above and below Toledo, WA August or September of 2016

Guided by Mike Olinger

You and your best guest will be on a jet boat running up and down the river depending on water flows and fishing locations

You will be able to fish either one- or two-handed rods

There can be instruction on the two-handed rod casting if you are so inclined

Recommended rod weights are 5-7 weight of either style

Extra rods and reels are available for use

You are welcome to bring your own favorite flies, but Mike will provide them as well

Steelhead typically run 6 to 8 pounds with some even larger

Sea Run Cutthroat run 14 to 18 inches

This is all 'fishing on the swing' primarily with floating lines and lightly weighted or un-weighted flies

You will see surface takes and learn to love the 'TUG'

Lodging is yet to be determined, but lunches will be supplied at a minimum, along with transportation to and from the river
